Introduction

This course helps instructors think about how they can challenge their students to ensure they are acquiring the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need to succeed in the field. It explores the corresponding learning domains (cognitive, psychomotor, and affective) and challenges the instructor to select appropriate learning activities for their students. In scenarios, instructors also assess whether or not their students are "getting it" and specify the key assessment indicators.
